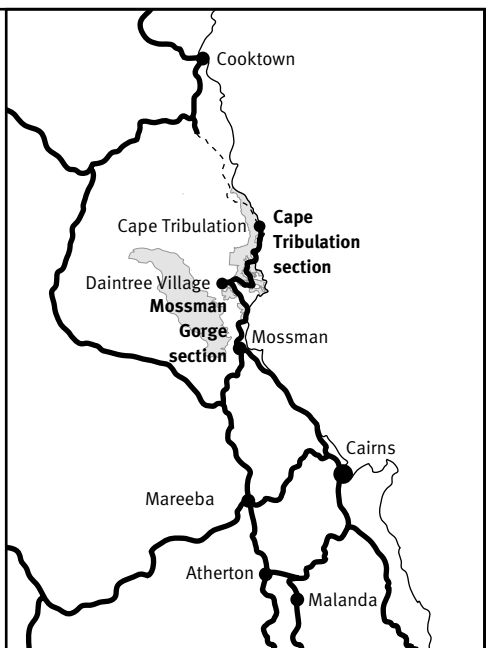
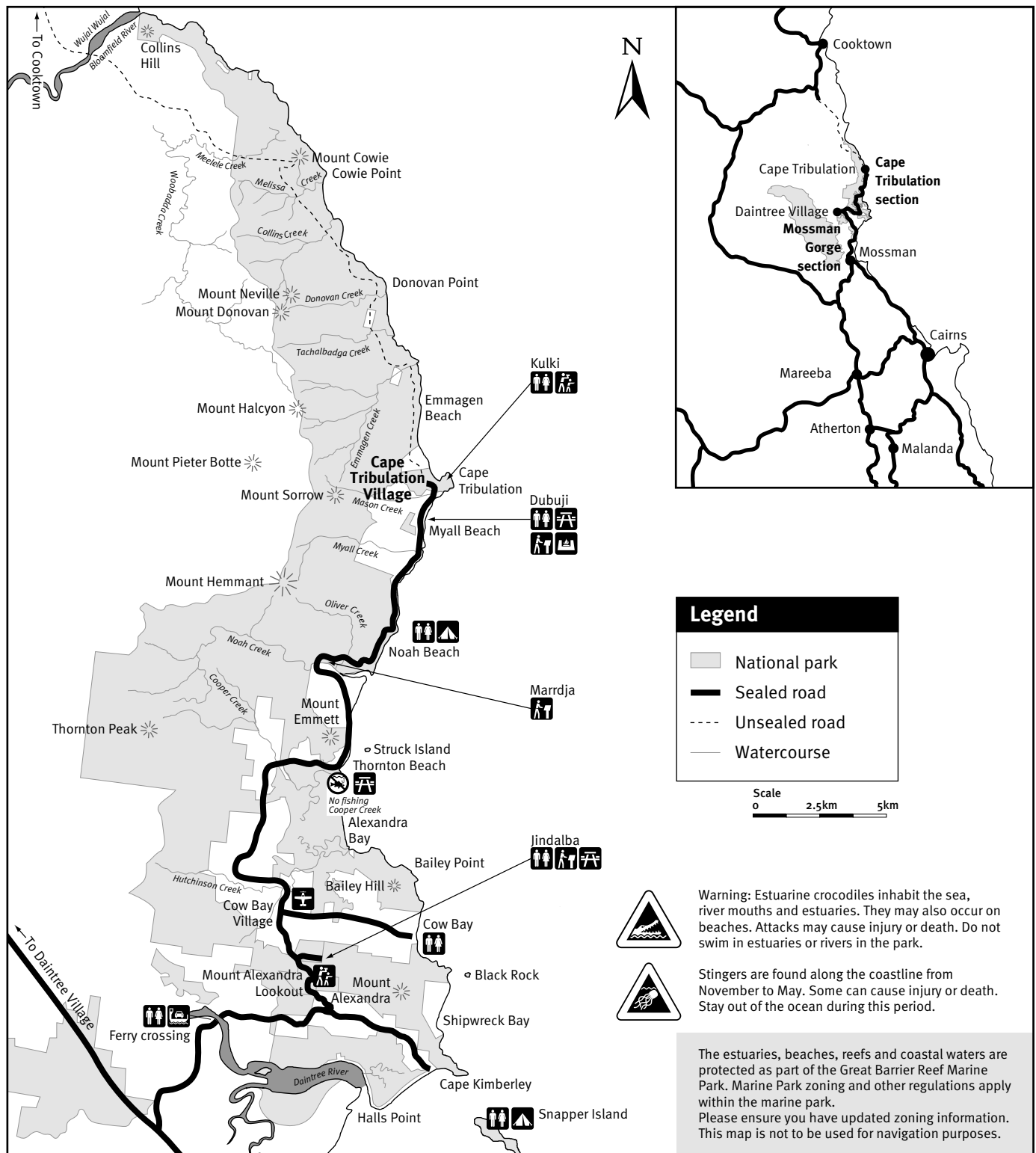


Cape Tribulation

Warning: Estuarine crocodiles inhabit the sea, river mouths and estuaries. They may also occur on beaches. Attacks may cause injury or death. Do not swim in estuaries or rivers in the park.



Stingers are found along the coastline from November to May. Some can cause injury or death. Stay out of the ocean during this period.

The estuaries, beaches, reefs and coastal waters are protected as part of the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park. Marine Park zoning and other regulations apply within the marine park. Please ensure you have updated zoning information. This map is not to be used for navigation purposes.
